ORDINARY BUSINESS:

1. To receive, consider and adopt the Audited Financial Statements for the year ended 31st March, 2026 together with the Reports of Directors and Auditors thereon.
2. To appoint Ms. SARIKA SSANGAVI (DIN: 11256382), who retires by rotation in accordance with the provisions of Section 152(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 and, being eligible, offers herself for re-appointment.

SPECIAL BUSINESS:

3. Re appointment of Mr. Sarthak Sanghavi (DIN: 10277570) as a Whole time Director of the Company.

To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an Ordinary Resolution:

“**RESOLVED THAT** pursuant to the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee and in accordance with the provisions of Sections 196, 197 and 203 read with Schedule V and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Companies (Appointment and Remuneration of Managerial Personnel) Rules, 2014, including any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force, and subject to such approvals as may be required, the consent of the members of the Company be and is hereby accorded for the reappointment of Mr. Sarthak Sanghavi (DIN: 10277570) as Whole-Time Director, designated as Executive Director of the Company, for a further period of three (3) years, with effect from 02.12.2026 to 01.12.2029, upon expiry of his existing term on 01.12.2026 on the terms and conditions, including remuneration, as set out in the explanatory statement annexed to the Notice of this Meeting, with liberty to the Board of Directors of the Company (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”, which term shall include the Nomination and Remuneration Committee thereof) to alter and vary the terms and conditions of the said reappointment and/or remuneration from time to time, as it may deem fit and as may be acceptable to Mr. Sarthak Sanghavi, provided that such remuneration shall not exceed the limits specified under Section 197 read with Schedule V to the Companies Act, 2013, or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof.”

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”) vide its Circular Nos. 20/2020 dated 05.05.2020, 02/2021 dated 13.01.2021, 19/2021 dated 08.12.2021, 21/2021 dated 14.12.2021, 2/2022 dated 05.05.2022, 10/2022 dated 28.12.2022, 09/2023 dated 25.09.2023, 09/2024 dated 19.09.2024 and 03/2025 dated 22.09.2025 and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated 13.05.2022, SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated 05.01.2023, SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2023/167 dated 07.10.2023 and SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/P/CIR/2024/133 dated 03.10.2024 read with Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated 11.11.2024 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) (collectively referred to as “the Circulars”) permitted the holding of the Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) through Video Conference (VC) / Other Audio Visual Means (OAVM), without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. In compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (“Act”), SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“SEBI LODR”) and the Circulars, the AGM of the Company is being held through VC / OAVM.
2. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC / OAVM will be counted for ascertaining the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
3. Since the AGM will be held through VC / OAVM, the Route Map, Attendance Slip and Proxy Form are not attached to this Notice.
4. Though a Member, pursuant to the provisions of the Act, is entitled to attend and vote at the meeting, is entitled to appoint one or more proxies (proxy need not be a Member of the Company) to attend and vote instead of himself / herself, the facility of appointment of proxies is not available as this AGM is convened through VC / OAVM pursuant to the Circulars.
5. In case of joint holders attending the AGM, only such joint holder who is higher in the order of names as per the Register of Members of the Company will be entitled to vote during the AGM.
6. The Register of Members and the Share Transfer Books of the Company will remain closed from 19th September 2026 to 25th September, 2026 (both days inclusive).
7. Members are requested to intimate the changes in their respective mailing address either to the Company or RTA in case of shares held in physical form or to their respective Depository Participants (DPs) in case of shares held in dematerialized form.
8. SEBI vide Circulars dated 3rd November, 2021, 14th December, 2021 and 16th March, 2023, mandated furnishing of PAN, Nomination, Contact details, Bank Account details and Specimen signature of the holders of physical securities for their corresponding folio numbers through respective Forms. In case of Folios wherein any one of the abovementioned documents /

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details not available on or after 1st October, 2023, the said folios shall be frozen by the RTA. Further, compulsory linking of PAN and Aadhaar by all the holders of physical securities should be completed within the date extended by the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT)[(i.e.) 30th June, 2023]. The folios in which PANs are not linked with Aadhaar numbers as on the notified cut-off date (i.e.) 30th June, 2023 or any other date as may be specified by the CBDT, shall also be frozen.

9. Members who have not yet registered their e-mail addresses are requested to register the same with their DPs, in case the shares are held in electronic form and with the Company / RTA, in case the shares are held in physical form.
10. SEBI vide Circular dated 25th January, 2022 mandated issuance of Securities in Dematerialized Form in case of Investor Service Requests viz., Issue of Duplicate Share Certificates, Claim from Unclaimed Suspense Account, Renewal/Exchange of Share Certificates, Endorsement, Sub-division/Splitting of Share Certificates, Consolidation of Share Certificates / Folios, Transmission, Transposition, etc.
11. In line with the MCA Circulars, the Notice convening the AGM and the Annual Report for the year 2025-26 are made available on the website of the Company at www.shantiguruindustries.com and also on the website of the Stock Exchange (i.e.) BSE Limited at www.bseindia.com. The Notice and the Annual Report are also made available on the website of CDSL (agency providing the remote e-Voting facility and e-Voting system during the AGM)(i.e.) www.evotingindia.com.
12. The Register of Directors and Key Managerial Personnel and their shareholdings maintained under Section 170 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Register of Contracts or Arrangements maintained under Section 189 of the said Act, will be available electronically for inspection by the Members during the AGM.
13. All documents referred to in the Notice will also be available for electronic inspection without any fee by the Members from the date of circulation of this Notice upto the date of AGM (i.e.) 25th September, 2026. INFORMATION AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONS RELATING TO E-VOTING SYSTEM:

(1) Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended and Regulation 44 of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015, the Company is pleased to provide remote e-Voting as well as e-Voting facility during the AGM to its Members through Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL), in respect of the businesses to be transacted at the 16th Annual General Meeting.

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(2) The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 15 minutes before and after the scheduled time of the commencement of the Meeting by following the procedure mentioned in the Notice. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available to atleast 1000 members on first come first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders Relationship Committee, Auditors etc. who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction on account of first come first served basis.

(3) The Company has appointed M/s A K Jain & Associates, Practising Company Secretaries represented by its Partner – Mr. Balu Sridhar (M. No. F5869, CP 3550) as the Scrutinizer for conducting both the remote e-Voting and e-Voting during the AGM in a fair and transparent manner and they have communicated their willingness for the same.

(4) The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-Voting may also attend the meeting but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again during the AGM.

(5) The voting rights of the Members / Beneficial Owners shall be reckoned on the Equity Shares held by them as on 18th September 2026 being the “cut-off” date. Members of the Company holding shares either in physical or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date, may cast their vote through remote e-Voting or e-Voting system available during the AGM.

(6) A person, whose name is recorded in the Register of Members or in the Register of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on the cut-off date (i.e.) 18th September, 2026 only shall be entitled to avail the facility of e-Voting.

(7) The Scrutinizer, after first scrutinizing the votes cast through e-Voting system available during the AGM and thereafter, the votes cast through remote e-Voting will, not later than two days of conclusion of the meeting, make a Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report and submit the same to the Chairman for declaring the results.

(8) The results declared along with the Consolidated Scrutinizer's Report shall be placed on the Company's website www.shantiguruindustries.com and on the website of CDSL www.evotingindia.com. The results shall simultaneously be communicated to the Stock Exchange.

(9) Subject to the requisite number of votes cast in favour of the Resolution(s), the same shall be deemed to be passed on the date of the meeting (i.e.) 25th September, 2026. Instructions to Members with regard to remote e-voting, attending and e- voting at the AGM of the Company held through Video Conferencing ('VC') other permitted Audit Visual Means ('OAVM') as an e-AGM:

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THE INTRUCTIONS OF SHAREHOLDERS FOR E-VOTING AND JOINING VIRTUAL MEETINGS ARE AS UNDER:

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

Step 2 : Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode

(i) The voting period begins on Tuesday, 22nd September, 2026 at 10.00 A.M and ends on Thursday, 24th September, 2026 at 5.00 P.M. During this period, shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date, Friday 18th September, 2026 (record date) may cast their vote electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

(ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue.

(iii) Pursuant to **SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 09.12.2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting **to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

(iv) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository

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Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

- (x) On the voting page, you will see “RESOLUTION DESCRIPTION” and against the same the option “YES/NO” for voting. Select the option YES or NO as desired. The option YES implies that you assent to the Resolution and option NO implies that you dissent to the Resolution.
- (xi) Click on the “RESOLUTIONS FILE LINK” if you wish to view the entire Resolution details.
- (xii) After selecting the resolution, you have decided to vote on, click on “SUBMIT”. A confirmation box will be displayed. If you wish to confirm your vote, click on “OK”, else to change your vote, click on “CANCEL” and accordingly modify your vote.
- (xiii) Once you “CONFIRM” your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.
- (xiv) You can also take a print of the votes cast by clicking on “Click here to print” option on the Voting page.
- (xv) If a demat account holder has forgotten the login password then Enter the User ID and the image verification code and click on Forgot Password & enter the details as prompted by the system.

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(xvi) There is also an optional provision to upload BR/POA if any uploaded, which will be made available to scrutinizer for verification.

(xvii) **Additional Facility for Non – Individual Shareholders and Custodians –For Remote Voting only.**

- Non-Individual shareholders (i.e. other than Individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) and Custodians are required to log on to www.evotingindia.com and register themselves in the “Corporates” module.
- A scanned copy of the Registration Form bearing the stamp and sign of the entity should be emailed to helpdesk.evoting@cdslindia.com.
- After receiving the login details a Compliance User should be created using the admin login and password. The Compliance User would be able to link the account(s) for which they wish to vote on.
- The list of accounts linked in the login will be mapped automatically & can be delink in case of any wrong mapping.
- It is Mandatory that, a scanned copy of the Board Resolution and Power of Attorney (POA) which they have issued in favour of the Custodian, if any, should be uploaded in PDF format in the system for the scrutinizer to verify the same.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHAREHOLDERS ATTENDING THE AGM/EGM THROUGH VC/OAVM & E-VOTING DURING MEETING ARE AS UNDER:

1. The procedure for attending meeting & e-Voting on the day of the AGM/ EGM is same as the instructions mentioned above for e-voting.
2. The link for VC/OAVM to attend meeting will be available where the EVSN of Company will be displayed after successful login as per the instructions mentioned above for e-voting.
3. Shareholders who have voted through Remote e-Voting will be eligible to attend the meeting. However, they will not be eligible to vote at the AGM/EGM.
4. Shareholders are encouraged to join the Meeting through Laptops / IPads for better experience.
5. Further shareholders will be required to allow Camera and use Internet with a good speed to avoid any disturbance during the meeting.

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6. Please note that Participants Connecting from Mobile Devices or Tablets or through Laptop connecting via Mobile Hotspot may experience Audio/Video loss due to Fluctuation in their respective network. It is therefore recommended to use Stable Wi-Fi or LAN Connection to mitigate any kind of aforesaid glitches.
7. MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS REPORT

We herewith submit the Management Discussion and Analysis Report on the business and operations of **SHANTI GURU INDUSTRIES LIMITED** ("the Company") for the financial year ended **31st March, 2026**.

ECONOMY :

The Indian economy continued to demonstrate strong resilience during FY 2025–26. According to the provisional estimates released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), India's **Real GDP is estimated to have grown by 7.8% during FY 2025–26**, compared with growth of 7.1% in FY 2024–25. The growth was supported by domestic consumption, investment activity, infrastructure development and continued momentum in the services sector.

The economy benefited from stable domestic demand, improving purchasing power, infrastructure investments and continued policy support for manufacturing and economic development. The services sector also remained a major contributor to economic activity and is estimated to have grown by approximately **9.1% in FY 2025–26**.

Inflationary pressures remained relatively contained during FY 2025–26. Consumer demand was supported by improving purchasing power and favourable economic conditions. At the same time, global economic uncertainties, geopolitical developments, commodity price volatility and changes in international trade policies continued to remain important areas of consideration.

India's large domestic market, favourable demographic profile, expanding consumer base and continued investments in infrastructure and manufacturing provide a strong foundation for sustainable economic growth.

INDUSTRY

The **Fast-Moving Consumer Goods (FMCG)** sector continued to remain an important component of India's consumption-driven economy during FY 2025–26. The sector witnessed healthy growth, supported by consumer demand, rural consumption, improving purchasing power, smaller pack sizes, wider distribution networks and increasing adoption of e-commerce and digital channels.

According to NielsenIQ data, India's FMCG market recorded **13.9% value growth and 6% volume growth during Q1 FY2025–26**, with rural demand continuing to be an important growth driver.

The consumption environment also showed signs of rebalancing during the year, with urban markets demonstrating resilience while rural growth moderated from earlier levels. This indicates a broadening of the consumption recovery rather than dependence on any single market segment.

The food and packaged food segment continues to benefit from changing lifestyles, increasing urbanization , rising consumer awareness and increasing preference for convenient, affordable and quality food products.

However, the biggest challenge faced today is to maintain volume growth and consumer affordability while input costs, competition and distribution costs are increasing.

FINACIAL PERFORMANCE

During the financial year under review, the Company's total assets increased from ₹146.99 crore to ₹279.54 crore. The net worth also increased from ₹136.83 crore to ₹249.15 crore, representing a growth of approximately 82.09%. The increase was primarily attributable to the significant growth in investments and other equity during the year

HUMAN RESOURCES

The Company recognises its human resources as an important asset and continues to focus on maintaining a competent and committed workforce. The employees contributed towards the day-to-day operations and activities of the Company. The Company remains committed to providing a conducive work environment and supporting the professional development and well-being of its employees.

CHANGE IN NET WORTH

During the financial year under review, the net worth of the Company increased from ₹136.83 crore as at 31 March 2025 to ₹249.15 crore as at 31 March 2026, representing an increase of approximately 82.09%.

OUTLOOK

The outlook for the FMCG sector remains positive, supported by improving rural demand, gradual urban consumption recovery, expanding digital and quick-commerce channels, and increasing consumer spending. However, the sector is expected to face near-term challenges from volatile raw-material costs, margin pressures, intense competition and changing consumer preferences. Companies focusing on cost efficiency, product innovation, affordable offerings and wider distribution are expected to remain well positioned for sustainable growth.

OPPORTUNITY

India's expanding consumer market presents significant opportunities for companies operating in the food and FMCG segments. Rising disposable income, changing consumption patterns, increasing awareness of packaged food products and demand for convenience are expected to support the growth of the sector.

THREATS, RISKS & CONCERNS

The Company's operations are exposed to various risks associated with the FMCG, trading and food products sectors.

Volatility in the prices of raw materials, packaging materials, fuel, transportation and other inputs may affect operating costs and margins. The Company may also face competition from established FMCG companies, regional players and emerging brands.

Changes in consumer preferences, regulatory requirements, market conditions and product demand may impact the Company's operations and financial performance.

Global economic uncertainties, geopolitical developments, international trade policies, adverse weather conditions and supply-chain disruptions may also affect the availability and cost of raw materials.

The Company continues to monitor these risks and intends to take appropriate measures to mitigate their potential impact on its operations and financial performance.

SEGMENT-WISE PERFORMANCE

The Company's primary operating segment during FY 2025–26 was trading of marketable goods. Accordingly there are no separate reportable segments

NOTE 1 – BACKGROUND

Shanti Guru Industries Limited (Formerly known as RCL Retail Limited) was originally incorporated as a private limited company on 29.09.2010 in the State of Tamil Nadu which was subsequently converted to public company on 23.03.2011 having its registered office in Chennai. The Company is engaged in the business of retail trading. The company is in the process of setting up of manufacturing unit of processed foods.

NOTE 2 - BASIS OF PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

i. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (IND AS) notified under the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015 as amended from time to time.

ii. The significant accounting policies used in preparing the financial statements are set out in Note No. 3

NOTE 3 - SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

3.1 Property, Plant and Equipment (PPE)

(i) Property, Plant and Equipment are stated at cost of acquisition net of accumulated depreciation/ amortization and impairment losses if any, except free hold land which is carried at cost less impairment losses if any. The cost comprises purchase prices, borrowing cost if capitalization criteria are met and directly attributable cost of bringing the asset to its working condition for the intended use.

(ii) The Company identifies the significant parts of plant and equipment separately which are required to be replaced at intervals. Such parts are depreciated separately based on their specific useful lives. The cost of replacement of significant parts are capitalized and the carrying amount of replaced parts are de-recognized. When each major inception/ overhauling is performed, its cost is recognized in the carrying amount of the item of property, plant and equipment as a replacement if the recognition criteria are satisfied. Any remaining carrying amount of the cost of the previous inspection/ overhauling (as distinct from physical parts) is de- recognized.

(iii) Other expenses on fixed assets, including day-to-day repair and maintenance expenditure and cost of replacing parts that does not meet the capitalization criteria in accordance with IND AS 16 are charged to the Statement of Profit and Loss for the period during which such expenses are incurred.

(iv) PPEs are eliminated from the financial statements on disposal or when no further benefit is expected from its use or disposal. Gains or losses arising from disposal of plant, property and equipment are measured as the difference between the net disposal proceeds and the carrying amount of such assets are recognized in the statement of profit and loss.

(v) Depreciation for plant and machinery has been provided on Written down value method.

(vi) The residual values, useful lives and methods of depreciation of property, plant and equipment are reviewed at each reporting date and adjusted prospectively, if appropriate.

3.2 Current or Non-Current classification

An asset or liability is classified as current if it satisfies any of the following conditions:

- i) Asset or liability is expected to be realized in the company's normal settlement cycle.
- ii) Asset is intended for sale or consumption.
- iii) Asset or liability is held primarily for the purpose of trading.
- iv) Asset or liability is expected to be realized or settled within twelve months after reporting period.

3.3 Intangible assets

- i) The cost of computer software that are installed are accounted at cost of acquisition of such assets and are carried at cost less accumulated amortization and impairment, if any. Internally generated software is not capitalized and the expenditure is reflected in the statement of profit and loss in the year in which the expenditure is incurred.
- ii) The residual values, useful lives and methods of depreciation of intangible assets are reviewed at each reporting date and adjusted prospectively, if appropriate.

3.4 Inventories

- (i) Inventories are valued at cost or net realizable value whichever is lower. Cost includes the cost incurred in bringing the inventories to their present location and condition.
- (ii) Raw materials, stores and spares are valued at cost or net realizable value whichever is lower. Cost includes the cost incurred in bringing the inventories to their present location and condition. For cost calculation of Raw materials as it is not ordinarily inter changeable specific identification method is used. For cost calculation of stores and spares weighted average method is used.
- (iii) For valuation of finished goods / stock-in-process, cost includes material, direct labour, overheads (other than abnormal amount of wasted materials, storage costs, selling and administrative overheads) wherever applicable.

3.5 Revenue Recognition

- (i) Revenue is recognized to the extent that is probable that the economic benefits will flow to the company and the revenue can be reliably measured.
- (ii) Sale of products is recognized when the significant risk and reward of ownership of the goods have been passed to the buyer. Revenue is measured at fair value of the consideration received or receivable, after deduction of any taxes or duties collected on behalf of the government which are levied on sales such as VAT, GST, etc.
- (iii) Dividend income, if any, is recognized when the company's right to receive dividend is established by the reporting date.
- (iv) Interest income from financial assets is recognized at the effective interest rate applicable on initial recognition.
- (v) Scrap sales is recognized at the fair value of consideration received or receivable upon transfer of significant risk and rewards. It comprises of invoice value of goods and after deducting applicable taxes on sale.

3.6 Employee Benefits

The Company does not have any manufacturing activity. There are no permanent workers / employees as at the end of the year. Accordingly there are no liabilities with respect to Bonus, Gratuity, Provident Fund, Employees State Insurance, Leave Encashment and other retirement benefits.

3.7 Provision, Contingent Liability and Contingent Assets

Provision is recognised in respect of present obligation requiring settlement by outflow of resources and of which reliable estimate of the amount of obligation could be made.

Contingent liability is not recognised and is disclosed unless the possibility of outflow of resources embodying economic benefit is remote. Present obligation arising from past events and the existence of which is subject to occurrence or non-occurrence of an in certain future event is disclosed.

3.8 Cash Flow statement

Cash flows are reported using the indirect method, whereby profit before tax is adjusted for the effects of transactions of non-cash nature, any deferrals or accruals of past or future operating cash receipts or payments and item of income or expenses associated with investing or financing cash flows. The cash flows are segregated into operating, investing and financing activities.

3.9 Borrowing Cost

Interest and other cost in connection with borrowing of funds to the extent related / attributed to the acquisition/construction of qualifying fixed assets are capitalized up to the date when such assets are ready for its intended use. Other borrowing costs are charged to Profit and Loss Account.

3.10 Earnings Per Share

Basic Earnings per share is calculated by dividing the Net profit or loss after tax attributable to equity shareholders by the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding during the year. Diluted EPS is determined by adjusting the Profit or loss attributable to equity shareholders and the weighted average number of equity shares outstanding for the effects of all dilutive potential equity shares.

3.11 Income Tax

The tax provision is considered as stipulated in IND AS 12 and includes current and deferred tax liability. The company recognizes the accumulated deferred tax asset based on accumulated time difference using current tax rate. Both the current tax and deferred tax liability relating to items recognized outside the profit or loss is recognized either in "Other Comprehensive Income" or directly in "Equity" as the case may be.

3.12 Segment Reporting

The Company's Operating segment is identified based on nature of activity, risks and returns. The Company is primarily engaged in Trading of all kinds of tradeable and marketable goods - Operating Segment.

3.13 Impairment of Non-financial Assets

- (i) The carrying values of non-financial assets are reviewed for impairment at each Balance Sheet date, if there is any indication of impairment based on internal and external factors.
- (ii) Non-financial assets are treated as impaired when the carrying amount of such asset exceeds its recoverable value. After recognition of impairment loss, the depreciation / amortization for the said assets is provided for remaining useful life based on the revised carrying amount, less its residual value if any, on straight line basis.
- (iii) An impairment loss is charged to the Statement of Profit and Loss in the year in which an asset is identified as impaired.
- (iv) An impairment loss is reversed when there is an indication that the impairment loss may no longer exist or may have decreased.

3.14 Financial Instruments

A financial instrument is a contract that gives rise to a financial asset of one entity and a financial liability or equity instrument of another entity. Financial assets and financial liabilities are recognized when the Company becomes a party to the contractual provisions of the relevant instrument and are initially measured at fair value. Transaction costs that are directly attributable to the acquisition or issue of financial assets and financial liabilities (other than financial assets and financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss) are added to or deducted from the fair value of the financial assets or financial liabilities at fair value through profit or loss are recognized immediately in profit or loss.

3.15 Financial Assets

(i) Financial assets comprise of investments in Equity, Trade Receivables, Cash and Cash Equivalents and Other Financial Assets.

(ii) Depending on the business model (i.e) nature of transactions for managing those financial assets and its contractual cash flow characteristics, the financial assets are initially measured at fair value and subsequently measured and classified at:

- a) Amortized cost; or
- b) Fair value through Other Comprehensive Income (FVTOCI); or
- c) Fair value through Profit or Loss (FVTPL)
- d) Amortized cost represents carrying amount on initial recognition at fair value plus or minus transaction cost.

(iii) The Company classifies its financial assets for measurement as below:-

- a. Trade receivables, Loan and advances given to employees and related parties, deposits and other advances recoverable in cash or kind - Amortized Cost
- b. Investment in Equity instruments – FVTPL

(iv) The company derecognises a financial asset when the contractual rights to the cash flows from the asset expire, or when it transfers the financial asset and substantially all the risks and rewards of ownership of the asset to another party. On derecognition of a financial asset or part thereof, the difference between the carrying amount measured at the date of recognition and the consideration received including any new asset obtained less any new liability assumed shall be recognized in the statement of profit and Loss.

(v) The company assesses at each balance sheet date whether the financial asset or group of financial assets is impaired. IND AS 109 requires expected credit losses to be measured through a loss allowance. The company recognizes lifetime expected losses for trade receivables that do not constitute a financing transaction. For all other financial assets, expected credit losses are measured at an amount equal to 12 month expected credit losses or at an amount equal to lifetime expected losses, if the credit risk on the financial asset has increased significantly since initial recognition.

3.16 Financial Liability

(i) Financial liabilities comprise of Borrowings from Banks, Trade payables, Derivative financial instruments, financial guarantee obligation and other financial liabilities.

(ii) The Financial Liabilities comprising Borrowings, trade payables, interest accrued, Unclaimed/ Disputed dividends, security deposits and other financial liabilities not for trading are measured at Amortized Costs

(iii) Financial liabilities are derecognised when and only when it is extinguished (i.e) when the obligation specified in the contract is discharged or cancelled or expired.

(iv) Upon de-recognition of its financial liabilities or part thereof, the difference between the carrying amount of a financial liability that has been extinguished or transferred to another party and the consideration paid including any non-cash assets transferred or liabilities assumed is recognized in the Statement of Profit and Loss.

3.17 Fair Value Measurement

(i) Fair value is the price that would be received to sell an asset or paid to transfer a liability in an orderly transaction between market participants at the measurement date.

(ii) The fair value of an asset or a liability is measured / disclosed using the assumptions that the market participants would use when pricing the asset or liability, assuming that the market participants act in the economic best interest.

(iii) All assets and liabilities for which fair value is measured are disclosed in the financial statements are categorised within fair value hierarchy based on the lowest level input that is significant to the fair value measurement as a whole.

The fair value hierarchy is described as below:

Level 1: Unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets or liabilities

Level 2: Valuation techniques for which the lowest level inputs that are significant to the fair value measurement are directly or indirectly observable.

Level 3: Valuation techniques for which the lowest level inputs that are significant to the fair value measurement are unobservable.

(iv) For assets and liabilities that are recognised in the Balance sheet on a recurring basis, the company determines whether transfers have occurred between levels in the hierarchy by reassessing categorisation at the end of each reporting period (i.e) based on the lowest level input that is significant to the fair value measurement as a whole.

(v) For the purpose of fair value disclosures, the company has determined the classes of assets and liabilities based on the nature, characteristics and risks of the assets or liabilities and the level of the fair value hierarchy as explained above.

(vi) The basis for fair value determination for measurement and / or disclosure purposes is detailed below:

Investments in Equity:

The fair value is determined by reference to their quoted prices at the reporting date. In the absence of the quoted price, the fair value of the equity is measured using generally accepted valuation techniques.

Non-derivative financial liabilities

The fair value of non-derivative financial liabilities viz, borrowings are determined for disclosure purposes calculated based on the present value of future principal and interest cash flows, discounted at the market rate of interest at the reporting date.

3.18 Significant Estimates and Judgements

The preparation of the financial statements requires management to make judgements, estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of revenues, expenses, assets and liabilities and the accompanying disclosures, and the disclosure of contingent liabilities.

Actual results could vary from these estimates. The estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimate is revised if the revision effects only that period or in the period of the revision or future periods, if the revision affects both current and future year's. Accordingly, the management has applied the following estimates / assumptions / judgements in preparation and presentation of financial statements:

(i) Property, Plant and Equipment, Intangible Assets and Investment Properties

The residual values and estimated useful life of PPEs, Intangible Assets and Investment Properties are assessed by technical team duly reviewed by the management at each reporting date. Wherever the management believes that the assigned useful life and residual value are appropriate, such recommendations are accepted and adopted for computation of depreciation/amortisation. Also, management judgement is exercised for classifying the asset as investment properties or vice versa.

(ii) Current Taxes

Calculations of income taxes for the current period are done based on applicable tax laws and management's judgement by evaluating positions taken in tax returns and interpretations of relevant provisions of law.

(iii) Contingent Liabilities

Management judgement is exercised for estimating the possible outflow of resources, if any, in respect of contingencies / claims / litigations against the Company as it is not possible to predict the outcome of pending matters with accuracy.

(iv) Impairment of Trade receivables

The impairment for financial assets are done based on assumptions about risk of default and expected loss rates. The assumptions, selection of inputs for calculation of impairment are based on management judgement considering the past history, market conditions and forward looking estimates at the end of each reporting date.

(v) Impairment of Non-financial assets (PPE/Intangible Assets / Investment Properties)

The impairment of non-financial assets is determined based on estimation of recoverable amount of such assets. The assumptions used in computing the recoverable amount are based on management judgement considering the timing of future cash flows, discount rates and the risks specific to the asset.

(vi) Fair value measurement of financial instruments

When the fair values of financial assets and financial liabilities could not be measured based on quoted prices in active markets, management uses valuation techniques including the Discounted Cash Flow (DCF) model, to determine its fair value. The inputs to these models are taken from observable markets where possible, but where this is not feasible, a degree of judgement is exercised in establishing fair values. Judgements include considerations of inputs such as liquidity risk, credit risk and volatility.
